Drop-off/pick-up

Please do not drop children early in the morning. If a child is not enrolled in clubs, be sure to pick them up when their classes end (15:30 for international year 1 to 4, 16:15 for Integrated and International year 5 and above). If your child has a club that day, pick up is promptly at 5 PM.

Please do not send your child with a fever or other illnesses to school. Please inform the school if your child has been sick.

Parking Guide Lines

Nursery, K1, K2, Prep, and Year 1-4: Please use the main gate for drop off/pickup. Do not park cars in the middle of the road.

Years 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9: Please use the second gate (high school). Drive in, drop children off and continue out on to the street. There is a parking area at the high school block if you need to stop and wait. The security guards monitor traffic. To ensure safety, older siblings can walk younger siblings to block A (the main building).

Morning Snacks

Lunch at SIS@BDNC for Year 1 and above is at 1pm. This later lunch time is necessary because many of our students have classes until 4.15pm followed by an after school club. When children move from Prep to Year 1 they take a few weeks to adjust to this later lunch time.

To help children make this adjustment, please give your children breakfast before they come to school. In primary school we offer a 'morning snack' at 10.15am. This is not breakfast and we encourage them to have breakfast before coming to school.
