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STEM UPDATE- Creative Thinking with Coding & Robotics!

Dear Parents,

Welcome, parents and students, to the November STEM newsletter! This month, our curriculum was fully focused on the field of Coding and Robotics, where students turned lines of code into action and brought technological ideas to life.

Primary School students began their journey by controlling physical robots and designing in 3D, then progressed to mastering core coding concepts to create their own digital products like animations and games. Meanwhile, Secondary students applied these skills to more complex engineering projects, from programming electronic blocks and sensor-equipped robots to building autonomous vehicles and sophisticated mechanical systems.

In parallel, the school has launched the “STEM Challenge Wall” – a weekly STEM challenge board aimed at maintaining the spirit of STEM exploration and learning throughout the school. Students are invited to take on fun STEM challenges that spark curiosity, the joy of discovery, and a proactive learning spirit.
